

Yes Virginia, You Can Trailer An All-Crop.

Below is some pictures provided by Evan David of St. Clair, Michigan that shows how he positioned an All-Crop 66 on his beaver-tail trailer. Despite having a 102” wide deck, The wheels of the machine rested only partly on the edge of the side rails. David placed planks on the side rails and ramp to get more width. After getting the combine on the deck/planks with a front end loader, the combine was put up on blocks, wheels removed, and strapped down. Good Job Evan!
